**Product Required:**

- 12 x 11” Fern Green Anagram Decorator Latex Balloons (990048)
- 12 x 11” Citrus Orange Anagram Decorator Latex Balloons (990047)
- 48 x 5” Poppy Red Anagram Decorator Latex Balloons (990077)
- 1 x “Birthday Cheer Connex” Supershape foil balloon (0917301)
- 1 x heavy weight – I used a house brick wrapped in Lime green tissue

**Construction Method:**

1. Inflate two Citrus Orange balloons to 10” with air, and tie into a duplet. Create another duplet with two Fern Green balloons, inflated with air to 10”. Twist these two duplets together into a cluster, keeping balloons of the same colour opposite.
2. Wrap the cluster created in step 1 onto Dacron line, which has previously been secured to the weight. Ensure that the balloons are as close to the weight as possible.
3. Create a four-balloon cluster using 5” Poppy Red balloons inflated to 4.5” with air. Wrap this cluster onto the line, positioning the balloons tight up against the previous cluster and nestling in the gaps.
4. Repeat the previous two steps a further 5 times, ensuring that the tension between the clusters is maintained at all times.
5. Tie off the Dacron to the top of the column.
6. Inflate the foil Supershape balloon with helium, attach a ribbon, and use the ribbon to tie the balloon tightly into the top of the column.
7. If this design is to be used outdoors, build it directly onto a baseplate with a 5 foot pole, rather than onto Dacron line.
