

Balloon Recipe

Invitation to the Ball

Perfect for themed events, children's parties, and anytime dreams may come true....

Estimated Cost: \$11

Labor: 15 minutes

Suggested Retail Price: \$25-\$30

Instructions:

1. Inflate the SuperShape, 19-inch star and 18-inch round balloons with helium, attach to ribbons and gather into a bouquet. Attach to the weight.

To create the pumpkin base:

2. Place the uninflated 17-inch crescents one atop the other in a neat stack so that they all line up perfectly.

3. Use a cable tie to secure all seven points (one from each balloon) together, at each end of the crescent. Place the cable tie about 0.5-inches in from the point and ensure it is securely tightened. (See diagram, right.)

4. Using a hand pump, carefully inflate six of the seven balloons. Do not over inflate!

5. Place the weight attached to the bouquet inside the pumpkin, ensuring that the ribbons emerge through the top center. Inflate the final crescent balloon.

6. To complete the design, tape up the tails of the crescents and add the air inflated and heat sealed 4-inch heart to the top.



Materials:

- 1 Cinderella SuperShape balloon (17757-01,02)
- 1 18" Cinderella Stardust balloon (09587-01,02)
- 2 19" Holographic Fireworks star balloons (16276-02)
- 7 17" Holographic Fireworks Crescents (16243-99)
- 1 4" Metallic Pastel Pink Heart (16466-99)
- 1 balloon weight, pink or blue
- Cable Ties
- Balloon ribbon
